Wound Healing Awareness Opportunity Patient Voices at FDA CDRH Public Health Forum

- The Center for Devices and Radiological Health (CDRH) is planning a Public Health Forum on Wound Healing to be held from 1-4pm on October 16, 2018 at the FDA in Silver Spring, MD.
- Chronic wound patients who have used one or more wound dressings, negative pressure wound therapy systems, debridement systems and wound closure devices (e.g. external/skin tissue adhesives) are eligible to volunteer.
- This event will include a panel of patients and health care providers. The discussion will center around wound care devices used for the management, treatment, imaging, or diagnosis of chronic wounds, such as diabetic foot ulcers, venous stasis ulcers, pressure ulcers and burns.
- Selected patients would provide a brief introduction about what type of chronic wound they have, for how long, and what medical devices they have used to manage their chronic wounds.
- The FDA does not provide any per diem or reimbursement of expenses.
