The Wound Healing Foundation, through the support of 3M Health Care, is pleased to announce the Wound Healing Foundation-3M Fellowship for the year 2018. This will mark the 19th anniversary of the 3M Fellow Award.

The WHF-3M Fellowship is a one-year \$15,000 gift to stimulate scientific research and career development of a young investigator or junior faculty member pursuing a career in wound healing research. The 2018 Fellowship recipient benefits by:

- Receiving \$15,000 for wound healing research
- Recognition at the 2018 Wound Healing Society annual meeting in Charlotte, North Carolina when the award is bestowed
- Recognition on the Wound Healing Foundation website
- Attend and present Fellowship research findings at the 2019 WHS Annual Meeting
- Co-moderate the Fellowship session at the 2020 WHS Annual Meeting
- Encouraged to submit completed research for publication in *Wound Repair and Regeneration*

The deadline for receipt of application submissions is November 21, 2017.
